Handling of Cement



Chemicals and appearances:

Odorless fine white to grey powder

Risk associated with use: Cement dust acts as a skin and respiratory irritant. Dust and wet cement act as a serious irritant

Personal Protection: Dust proof goggles should be worn, whenever there is a risk of wet mix entering the eyes. Protective clothing should be worn, including waterproof gloves, trousers and appropriate footwear

Storage: Store in dry conditions, preferably above ground on pallets protected by shrink wrapping - this will prevent moisture ingress and prolong shelf life

Disposal: Dispose of empty bags or material at an authorised disposal site

Fire: Not flammable

First Aid

Skin

Dermatitis, irritation, redness, pain

Wash well with plenty of soap and water for at least 15 minutes
Remove contaminated clothing. Seek medical advice. Wash clothing before re-use

Eyes

Irritation, stinging

Flush eyes with copious quantity of water.
If irritation persists, seek medical advice

Inhalation

Irritation to nose and throat.

Move to fresh air and rest. If symptoms persist seek medical advice

Swallowing

Nausea,

Do not Induce vomiting. Wash out mouth with water. Seek medical advice if deemed necessary
